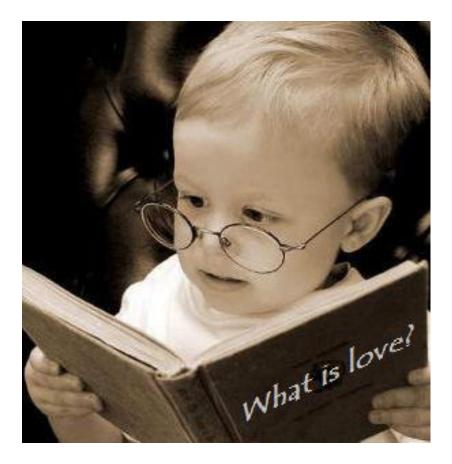


What is Love?

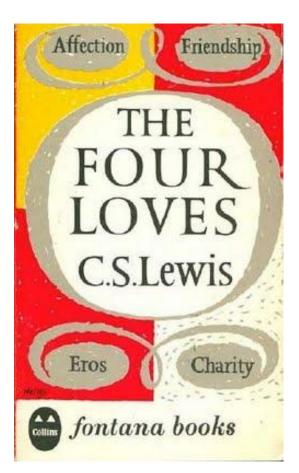
- One word many meanings

- Agape Selfless & Unconditional



Storge – Family/Community



- Chance proximity
- Natural love or affection
- Good Families are God's idea
- Not always emotional
- Often dutiful
- Can hinder us
 - Luke 14:26

Philio – Friendship/Brotherly

Chosen

- Based on shared values, interests & activities; people like us
- Highest form of love for ancients
- Often emotional
- Good Proverbs 8:31, John 16:27
- But "Even pagans do that" Matthew 5:46-47



Eros - Romantic



Chosen

- Being 'in love'
- Exemplified in marriage
- Good God's idea, Genesis
 2:18-25, Song of Songs
- Corrupted by selfish lust in Jesus' day; not mentioned in the Bible

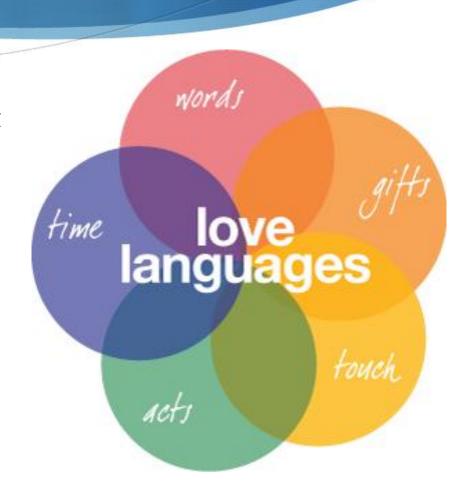
Agape – Selfless & Unconditional

- Hardly used before Jesus' day
- The defining word for Christianity
- Love that serves
 - Selfless, putting others first
- Everyone, even our enemies
 - Unconditional, but not treating everyone the same
- Laid down love John 15:13
 Epitomised by the cross



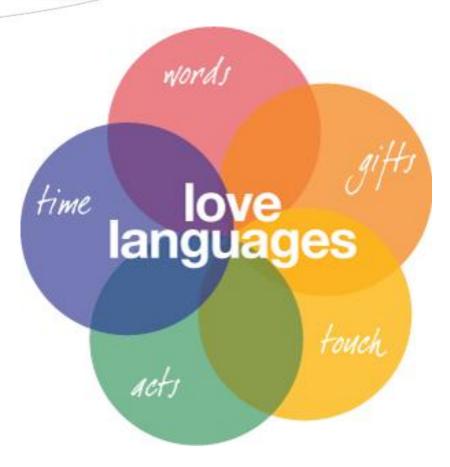
Agape Love Languages

- Touch identify with/accept
 - Embrace the unclean
- Words praise/esteem
 - Look for the gold
- Time honour
 - Grace with our presence



Agape Love Languages

- ♦ Service serve
 - But care for ourselves
- ♦ Gifts give
 - But beware motive

- Husbands agape your wives Eph 5:25
- Our best evangelism is to agape one another – John 13:35
- Without agape we are nothing 1 Corinthians 13:2
