Lena Mironova conducted a master class using microscopes. Children learnt about a microcosm and thanked God for the miracles of His creation.

Then all the children were given generous Christmas gifts – big cars, airplanes, backpacks, stationary, modelling clay and candy sets.





We are glad for Ksenia, who again joined with Dima. They bring together Yana, which is already one and a half year old. They are going to officially get married before Dima leave to serve in the army. We brought a big doll for Yana and lots of things for both her and Ksenia.





Artem, Pasha and Sasha finish school this summer. They then face a difficult time when they have to start caring for themselves. We are trying to help them obtain disability benefit and housing to which they are entitled, but they are unable to do this on their own.





We ended the day at a table with all the kids eating delicious pizza and lots of cakes and sweets. In general it was a real Christmas holiday for us all!
