Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a long sheet of clean linen cloth. He placed it in his own new tomb, which had been carved out of the rock. Then he rolled a great stone across the entrance and left. Both Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were sitting across from the tomb and watching. Matthew 27:59-61

A Witness to the resurrection

Early on Sunday morning, as the new day was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went out to visit the tomb. Suddenly there was a great earthquake! For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven, rolled aside the stone, and sat on it... The guards shook with fear when they saw him, and they fell into a dead faint. Then the angel spoke to the women. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He isn't here! He is risen from the dead... The women ran quickly from the tomb. They were very frightened but also filled with great joy, and they rushed to give the disciples the angel's message. And as they went, Jesus met them and greeted them. Matthew 28:1-9



Mary Magdelene What are we told? Apostle to the Apostles • Jesus said to them, "Don't be afraid! Go tell my brothers to leave for Galilee, and they will see me there" (Matt 28:10)

Mary Magdelene What are we told? Apostle to the Apostles • "go find my brothers and tell them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" (John 20:17)

Mary Magdelene What are we NOT told? 'Sinful woman anointing Jesus' Nowhere in the Bible is this woman identified as Mary Magdalene

"She whom Luke calls the sinful woman, whom John calls Mary, we believe to be the Mary from whom seven demons were ejected according to Mark. And what did these seven demons signify if not all the vices?... It is clear, brothers, that this woman previously used the unquent to perfume her flesh in forbidden acts. What she therefore displayed more scandalously, she was now offering to God in a more praiseworthy manner." Pope Gregory the Great AD 594

Mary Magdelene What can we learn about God's Kingdom? Female Women followers were always central to Jesus' ministry • Ladies – don't let anyone devalue you!!

Mary Magdelene What can we learn about God's Kingdom? Free of the past Mary didn't live in her past • She invested in her future • "So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free." John 8:36

Mary Magdelene What can we learn about God's Kingdom? Faithfulness Mary's faithfulness brought great reward • She is around when everyone else has gone • ὑπομένω (1 Cor 13:7)
