Let's get inspired to be the
'People of God' for today!

What's this about?

God invites all of humanity to be in relationship with Him - to be His very own people, as He is our very own God. The Bible tells the story of God's pursuit of us and all the ways people have responded. As we read the stories of the characters in its pages, we learn of His unending love, His constant goodness and His infinite ability to work through us to see His purposes fulfilled. Let's allow their experiences to teach us how to truly be "The People of God" today.

How do I do that?

We'll be reading our Bibles for 10 minutes a day, 5 days a week, tracing the stories of characters in the Bible through from Genesis into the New Testament over the course of the next year.

When is this happening?

Part 3 of "The People of God" begins on Monday 29th April and will finish on Friday 19th July, following the lives of Peter, John, Paul and Priscilla & Aquila

Each week's reading will form the basis of the talk on the upcoming Sunday morning.

READ:

What does the passage say? (Try reading it in different translations.)

ASK:

What does the passage mean? (A good Bible commentary can help.)

APPLY:

What does this passage tell me about God?

- What can I learn from this Bible character's successes?
- What can I learn from this Bible character's mistakes and failures?
- Is there an example to follow?

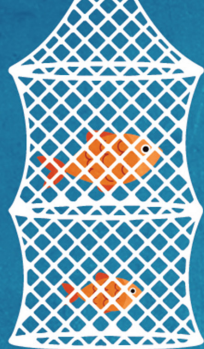
