About Us

The Hub is a community outreach project initiated and run by The Journey Church in Englefield Green. Established in 2012, it serves as place for all people in the local community to come together. A programme of regular, tailored activities runs throughout the week including youth and children's clubs, workshops, cafe and garden project, cooking club, Sunday lunches, community days and much more. The Role

- To work with The Journey leadership team to manage and develop The Hub activities
- To ensure that the premises are available and fit for purpose at the appropriate times
- To oversee and support volunteers to enable the smooth running of the Hub operations and activities; ensure and build a motivated and skilled volunteer team with a culture of good practice and excellence
- To successfully network with outside authorities, agencies and the local community, including fundraising
- To manage the risks and users of the site, both internal (The Journey) and external (e.g. outside community, hirers, agencies etc)
- To be a role model and key influence for good in the community

Key Responsibilities

- Ensuring the Hub building is fit for purpose and open and available when required, including organising any repairs, compliance with fire regulations and Control of Substances Hazardous to Health ("COSHH")
- Building relationships with the local community, schools and agencies
- Working with key stakeholders, local agencies and The Journey leadership
- Managing the recruitment and expansion of the volunteer teams to ensure a culture of excellence and mutual support
- Working with local agencies and volunteers to promote and start-up new activities and clubs that provide a positive experience for the local community
- Managing the Hub expenditure within the approved budget or the funds available
- Seeking and applying for new sources of income whenever appropriate, and accounting for expenditure with funders as necessary
- Ensuring best practice and safeguarding procedures are adhered to; ensuring that risk assessments are in place for group outings and activities
- Promote communication, networking, publicity and good administration of the Hub to the local community; including maintaining email distribution lists, social media, and The Hub website, and updating these regularly with news and upcoming events

- Ability to creatively develop the activities of the Hub
